Their flat pink flowerheads are perfect for autumn and frosty mornings, they also look great in tubs.

# Autumn and winter Patio Pots



Traditional autumn bedding plants are pansies, violas, primroses and polyanthus along with bellis and wallflowers.

If you want a consistent show then it's all about planting in combinations because traditional autumn bedding plants don't do much when it's very cold and wintry. You are really better off with evergreens that have the built-in antifreeze that flowers lack:



Gaultheria procumbens Wintergreen is a naturally festive looking, neat, low-spreading evergreen with large red berries and reddish-tinged leaves in winter.



Carex are tuftforming evergreen grasses with green, variegated or bronze, curly or arching leaves. Very tough and contemporary, they will look good all winter.



Hellebores can also flower early, it depends on variety, Nigra will often start before Christmas.



Euonymus, Pieris, variegated Ivies and hardy evergreen grasses can give a cheerful show whatever the weather and go on to complement your later plantings.



Remember to add some small bulbs like Snowdrops, Scillas, dwarf crocus and Narcissi, you should get flowers from the middle/ end of Jan onwards.
